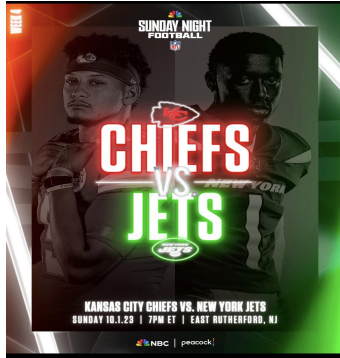


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NFL Primetime Games Week 4

Week 4 of the NFL primetime games is over and let's take a look at what the NFL teams did. Thursday Night Football kicked off with the Green Bay Packers hosting the Detroit Lions. The Lions running game dominated throughout the contest. Detroit running back, David Montgomery, ran for 121 yards on 32 attempts, scoring 3 touchdowns. The Green Bay Packers struggled on offense. Quarterback Jordan Love threw for 246 yards on 23-36 passing attempts. Love threw 2 interceptions to the Detroit defense as well as getting sacked 5 times. The Detroit Lions won and improved to 3-1.

Sunday Night Football hosted a primetime fixture between the Kansas City Chiefs and the New York Jets. The Chiefs offense came out firing early, scoring 17 first quarter points. Zach Wilson struggled in the first half, but came alive in the second half. Wilson threw for 245 yards for two touchdowns with efficient play. Patrick Mahomes threw 2 interceptions, right to jets defenders. The Kansas City Chiefs relied on the running game, and running back Isiah Pacheco carried throughout. Pacheco rushed for 115 yards on 20 carries, as well as adding one touchdown. The New York Jets mounted a comeback to the tie game at 20 all, but in the end the Kansas City Chiefs came out victorious 23-20.

Monday Night Football kicked off with the New York Giants hosting the Seattle Seahawks. The Seahawks defense was all over Giants quarterback Dasniel Jones sacking him 11 times; the most a team has sacked a quarterback in 5 years. The Seattle defense put the Seahawks offense into good field position, which led to easy touchdowns and chip shot field goals. Jones threw 2 interceptions with one of the picks being a 97 yard pick-6 to rookie cornerback Devon Witherspoon. The Seahawks defense lead the way to victory, beating the New York Giants 24-3. The Seahawks improve to 3-1 while the Giants fall to 1-3.
