San Francisco 49ers Week Seven Recap

Week seven of the NFL Football season is over; let's look at how the San Francisco 49ers did. The 49ers visited the Minnesota Vikings at U.S. Bank Stadium. The Vikings were without star receiver Justin Jefferson, while the 49ers were without stars Trent Williams and Deebo Samuel. The game started with a 20-yard touchdown pass from Kirk Cousins to Jordan Addison. Followed up by a 21-yard field goal by Greg Joseph to put the Vikings ahead 10-0.
