Drake Fires Back: Leaked Track Takes Aim at Kendrick Lamar and More

Following J. Cole's decision to remove his controversial track "7 Minute Drill," which was packed with shots aimed at Kendrick Lamar, Drake has apparently fired back with his own response on a leaked track titled "Push Ups (Drop and Give Me 50)." While the song hasn't been officially confirmed by Drake, it surfaced on social media recently, causing quite a stir among fans.

In the unconfirmed track, Drake doesn't hold back, taking aim not only at Lamar but also at several other rappers, as well as the entire Top Dawg Entertainment roster.
