Most Popular Transfers in Men's College Football

The top transfers in the portal this year were Sam Hartman from Wake Forest, Travis Hunter from Jackson State, Devin Leary from N.C. State, DJ Uiagalelei from Clemson, and Dominic Lovett from Missouri. Sam Hartman was the top-rated quarterback in the portal. Overall, he was rated 92.5 and the MVP in the Power Five Conference two seasons in a row. He is now at Notre Dame, where he is the starting quarterback leading them to a 6-2 record. Travis Hunter is at Colorado, where he followed former head coach, Deion Sanders. Ranked number 2 in the 2022 class, he decided to transfer to a more competitive conference. Travis was ranked 84 overall, being the top 15 defensive players among FCS cornerbacks. He currently has been playing both offense and defense, wide receiver and cornerback. He is just returning from an injury, but has helped lead Colorado to a record of 4-4. Devin Leary was among the top quarterbacks in the portal. With 31, he tied for the seventh-most big-time throws in the FBS. His season was cut short after six games due to a ruptured pectoral muscle last year, leading to a 64.8 passing rating. He is now at Kentucky, who sits at 5-2. DJ Uiagalelei transferred to Oregon State, leading the Beavers to a 6-2 record. He left Clemson due to being benched in the ACC Championship game. He has 17 touchdowns, four interceptions, a quarterback rating of 82.5. Dominic Lovett is now at Georgia. While at Missouri, he was All-Southeastern Conference (SEC), being their most thrown target. Currently, he has 35 receptions, averaging 10 yards per catch.
