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Most Popular Transfers in Women's College Volleyball

The top transfers in the portal this year were Mac Podraza, Jess Mruxik, Temi Thomas-Ailara, and Carter Booth. Mac Podraza transferred from Ohio State to Penn State. She won the 2022 Big Setter of the Year, made the 2022 Women's Collegiate National Team, and was a three-time All-American. Jess Mruxik transferred from Michigan State to Penn State. She won the 2019 National Gatorade Player of the Year, FIVB U18 World Champion MVP, two-time first-team All-Big 10, and AVCA All-Region. Mruxik averaged over 4.19 points per set last season. Temi Thomas-Ailara transferred from Northwestern to Wisconsin. With 502 kills and 4.33 kills per set, she led the Big Ten last season. With a career high of 26 kills and 17 digs. Carter Booth transferred from Minnesota to Wisconsin. As a freshman, she won first-team All-Big Ten, AVCA North Region Freshman of the Year, made the Big Ten All-Freshman Team and ranked fifth in the Big Ten and top 10 in the NCAA, she averaged 1.48 blocks per set.
