Latest Transfer Portal News in Men's Football

Football season is slowly wrapping up and some big names are in the transfer portal. Colorado loses two starters, Gerad Christian Litchenhan and Van Wells. Going 4-8, the center and lineman are leaving in hopes to attend a winning program. There are three highly rated quarterbacks in the portal. Cam Ward is transferring from Washington State, DJ Uiagalelei is transferring from Oregon State, and Will Howard is transferring from Kansas State. Combining for 61 touchdowns in his last two seasons and having increased his passing rating, Ward could potentially enter his name into the NFL draft but will most likely use his last year of eligibility on a new team. Throwing for 21 touchdowns, seven interceptions, and averaging nine yards per throw this season, Uiagalelei will most likely attend Michigan State next season.
