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Most Popular Transfers in Women's College Basketball

During this off-season, some big names decided to enter the transfer portal. These included Hailey Van Lith from Louisville, Aneesah Morrow from DePaul, Lauren Betts from Stanford, Jewel Spear from Wake Forest, and Celeste Taylor from Duke. Hailey Van Lith averaged 20 points per game, five rebounds, and four assists. She played extremely well in the NCAA tournament this year, hitting career highs against top-ranked opponents. LSU was in desperate need for a great guard, due to their former guard graduating. She was ranked the number one transfer in the portal, just right above her new teammate Aneesah Morrow.

Aneesah Morrow came off a great season at DePaul averaging a double-double, 25 points per game and 12 rebounds. She has played in 66 games in college, netting double-doubles in all of just 13 games. Lauren Betts is taking her talents to UCLA in hopes for some more playing time. She averaged only 9 minutes last season. A bit surprising considering she was the number one recruit in her class. Due to her helping Team USA to a silver medal over the summer, playing time will be not in the question at UCLA. Jewel Spear is transferring to Tennessee. She was Wake Forest's top option her past two years there, averaging 17 points per game, and hitting three threes per game. Tennessee was in desperate need for a top offensive player in their backcourt, so she'll be a great addition. Ohio State picked up the fourth-ranked steals leader in women's college basketball, Celeste Taylor. Duke last year held opponents to the second-fewest points in the country last season, she led the way with 3 steals per game. She also averaged 12 points, 5 rebounds, and 3 assists.
