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Most Popular Transfers in Men's College Baseball

The top transfers in the portal this year were Braden Montgomery, Billy Amick, Chase Burns, and Payton Tolle. Braden Montgomery transferred from Stanford to Texas A&M. He is a two-time Pac-12 team champion, ABCA All-America second team, ABCA All-Region first team, Pac-12 All-Conference, and USA Collegiate National Team. He hit .315 with 35 home runs and 118 RBI. He achieved a career-high .414 on-base percentage and a 603 slugging percentage. Billy Amick transferred from Clemson to Tennessee. He led the Tigers with a batting average of .413 and a slugging percentage of .772 after starting 42 of 46 games. He also added 63 RBIs and 13 home runs. Chase Burns transferred from Tennessee to Wake Forest. Burns had back-to-back seasons with triple-digit strikeout totals, with 114. With a 14.3 K/9, he currently stands second in the SEC and third nationally in strikeouts per nine innings. Payton Tolle transferred from Wichita State to TCU. Last season, Tolle had a 9-3 record as a pitcher. In 85.2 innings of work, he struck out 97 batters, up 48 strikeouts over his rookie campaign. The left-hander had a batting average of .311 and started in 55 games. Tolle finished the season with 50 RBIs and 66 hits, including 13 home runs.
