During this off-season, some big names decided to enter the transfer portal. These included Hunter Dickinson from Michigan, Ace Baldwin from VCU, Ryan Nembhard from Creighton, Max Abmas from Oral Roberts, and Harrison Ingram from Stanford. Hunter Dickinson was ranked the number one best player in the transfer portal. Listed at 7'2, he was one of the tallest players in the portal. Abmas is coming off a great year, averaging 22 points, 5 rebounds, and 4 assists per game. Harrison Ingram who averaged 11 points, 6 rebounds, and 4 assists will be heading to North Carolina. North Carolina needed a front court and wing scorer. They needed to find a balance for their star big man, Armando Bacot. He was asked to do a lot last year, putting him in some tough positions. Harrison will be a great addition to the Tarheels, relieving some pressure from Bacot.
